



10. Finally, clip the air vents and clock into position to complete the installation

Notes:

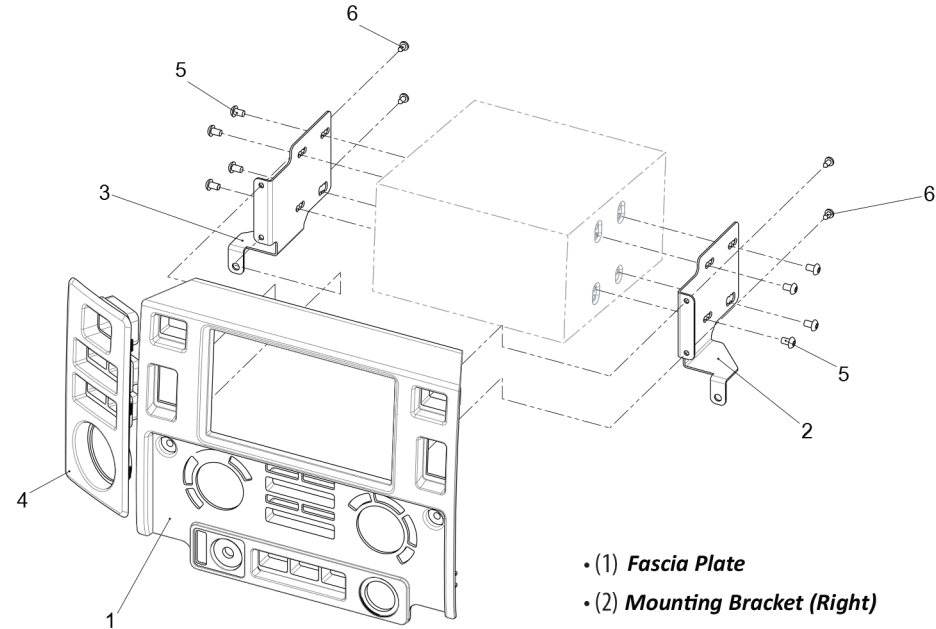
- 1) The installation must be completed with great care.

1. Firstly, remove the OEM radio using a suitable tool



2. Remove the TX-30 Torx screws

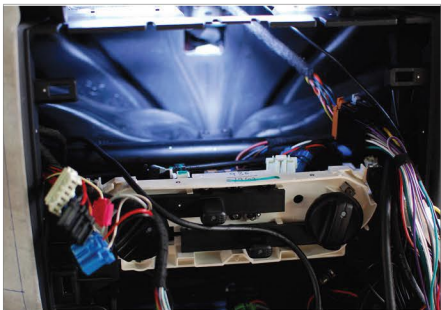


3. Remove the fascia, and then remove any buttons/switches.



4. Separate the air vents from the OEM fascia using a suitable tool

5. Remove the metal clips and reroute the air vent wiring (See image).



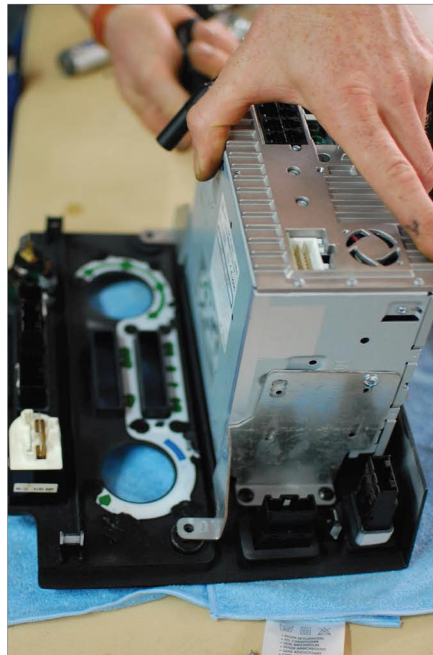
6. Measure the side panel and cut the dashboard accordingly.

Put the side panel back in.



7. Install the buttons/switches from your old fascia plate into your new one.
