





FAQ Troubleshooting

Q: Why does my climate not display on my aftermarket unit?

A: The Aerpro facia uses the reverse camera input and trigger on your aftermarket unit to display all information, such as HVAC, menus, reversing camera (if applicable). Make sure you have the male RCA and purple/white trigger wire from the FP9750 connected. Do not introduce another reverse trigger to the system. The trigger directly from the FP9750 loom must be used.

Also you may need to turn on a reverse camera setting within the head unit being fitted. (See Manual page 2-30)

Q: Why does 'Reverse' trigger my aftermarket radio, but no reversing image is displayed?

A: The reversing camera requires activation within the installer menu of the FP9750 kit. (Pages 17 & 18)

Q: Why does the fan on the facia not turn off when I lock my car.

A: There is a small fan on the rear of the facia, it will stay on for a few minutes after the car has been turned off and locked.

Q: Why does my factory dual zone climate only function as single zone after installation?

A: You need to change the AIR CON TYPE setting within the installer menu of the FP9750 kit from single (default) to dual. (Page 17)

Q: Why do my steering wheel controls (SWC) not work?

A: The included patch lead is an APUNIPL2, a universal patch lead to suit most aftermarket head units.

As the APUNIPL2 is a universal product make sure you have this configured to suit your brand of unit.

Up = Off, Down = On



1: On = Pioneer head units. Off = All other brand head units

2: Settings for reverse camera. On = PAL, Off = NTSC. The default setting is OFF.

3: Resets the display settings back to default. If the display settings have been manipulated in a way that is no longer possible to make adjustments, change DIPswitch #3 from Off to On and back. This will reset the screen settings to the factory defaults.

During this procedure the screen background will change to red. While the background is red, no settings can be made.

4: Not applicable. (This should be kept in the Up/Off position)
